He married Jane Foster on December 25, 1864, in McDonough County, Illinois. They had nine children in 14 years. He died on November 1, 1906, in St Joseph, Missouri, at the age of 64, and was buried in Agency, Missouri.

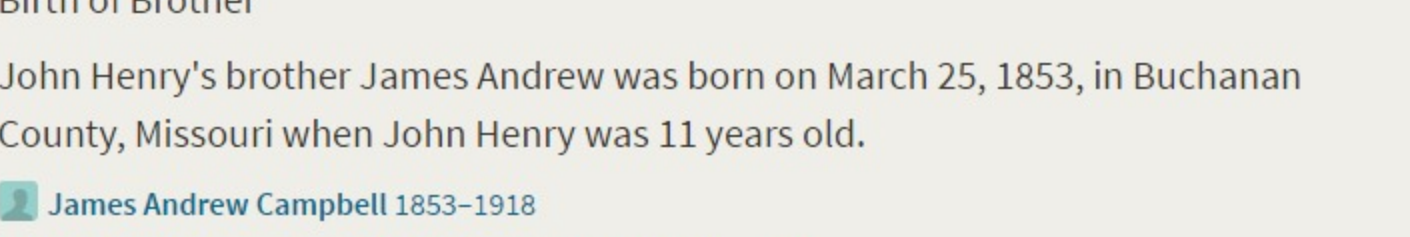

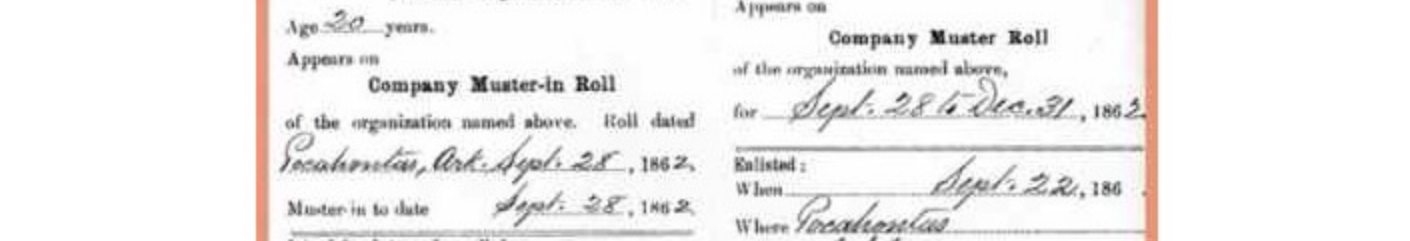

John Henry Campbell married Jane Foster on December 25, 1864, in McDonough County, Illinois, when he was 23 years old.

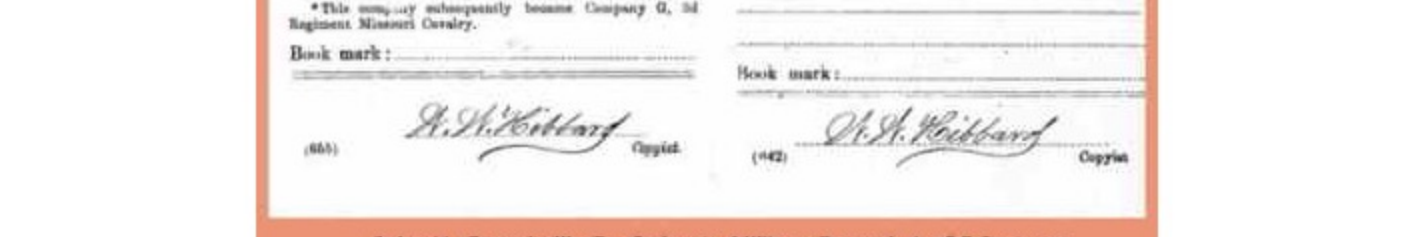


John Henry Campbell

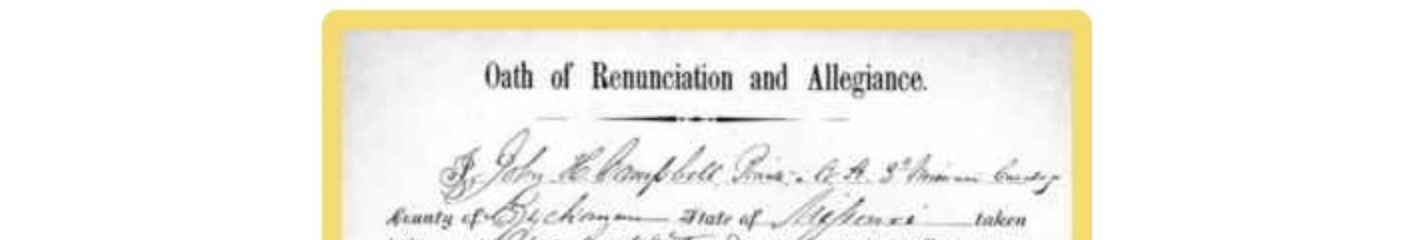

John Henry's father James Marion passed away on November 8, 1896, in Agency, Missouri, at the age of 79. 8 November 1896 - Agency, Buchanan, Missouri, United States

Death of Brother
John Henry's brother Stephen Albert died on December 23, 1896, when John Henry was 55 years old. 23 Dec 1896

His wife Jane passed away on September 8, 1905, in Albany, Missouri, at the age of 67. They had been married 40 years. 8 September 1905 - Albany, Gentry, Missouri, USA
