

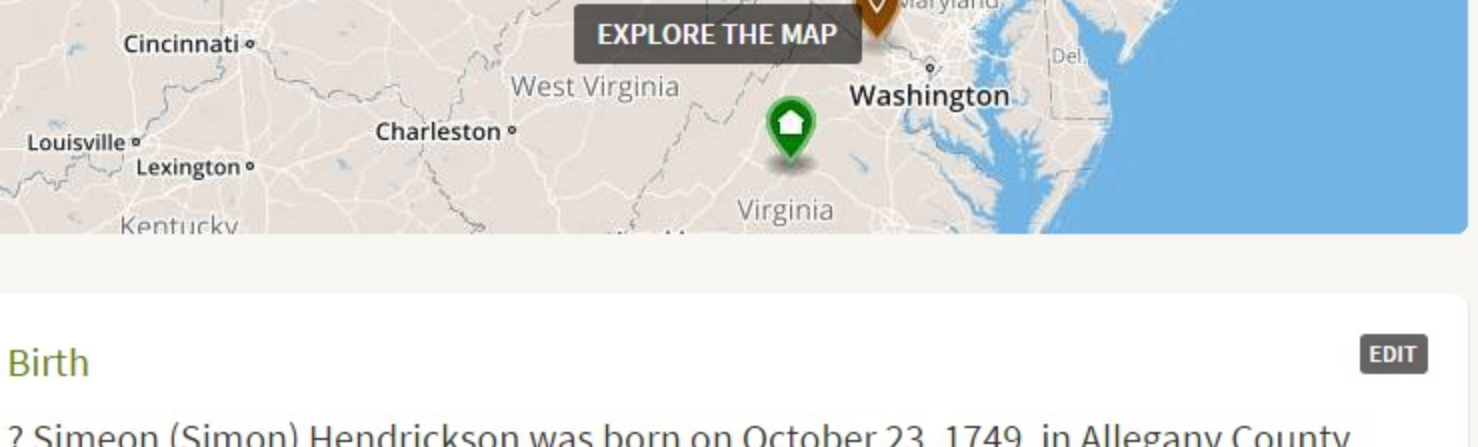
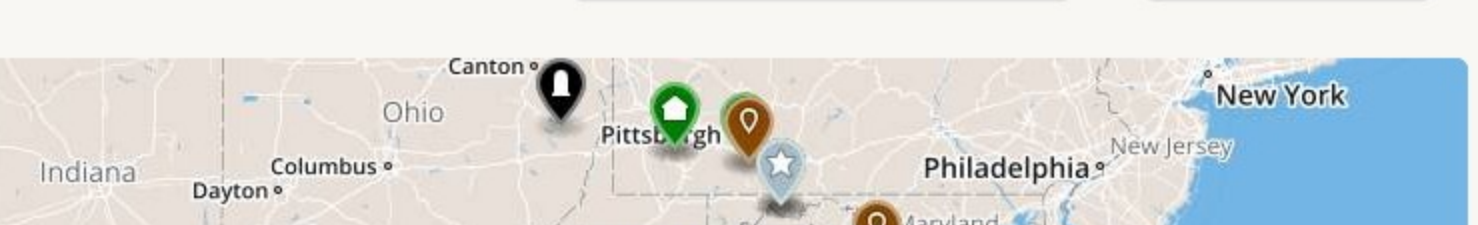

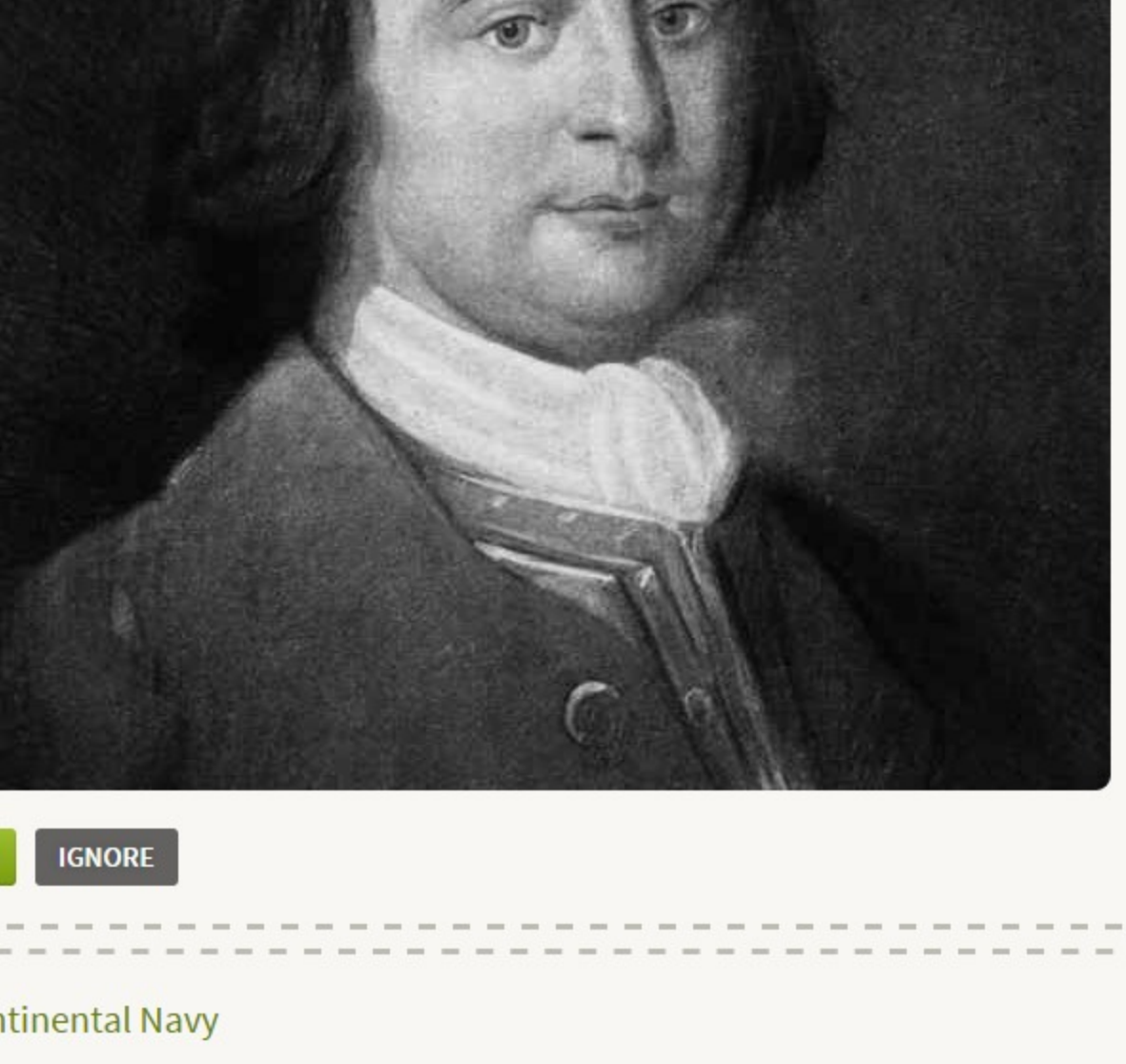

1769-1773 - Taxes Paid In Loudoun County, VA - formed from Fairfax Co. 1757

The Continental Navy

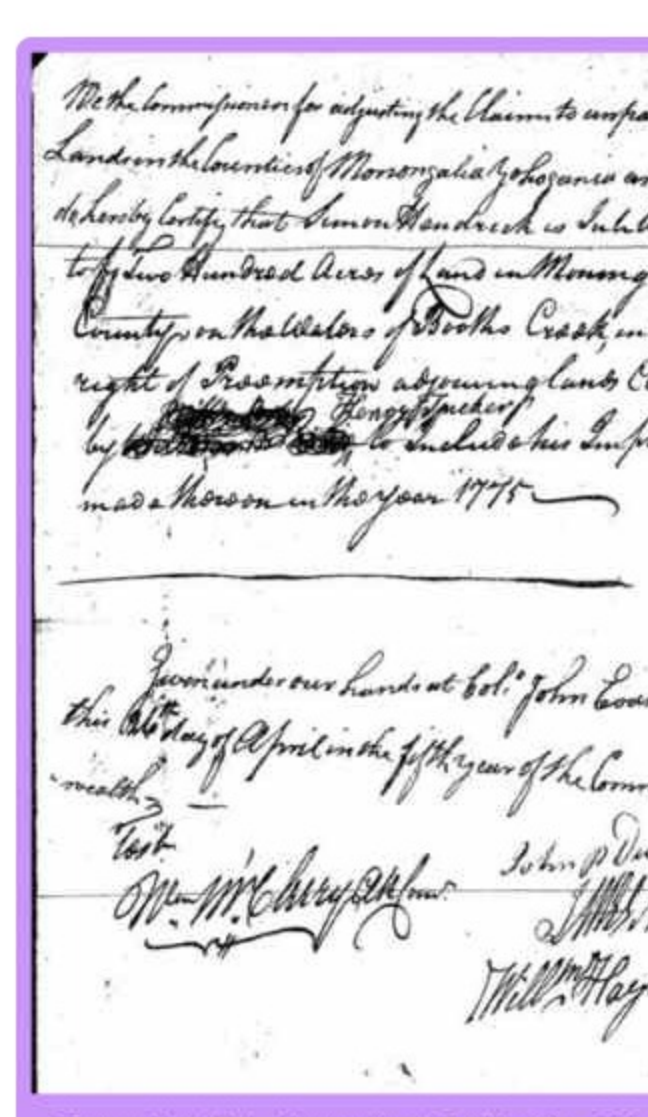
? Simeon (Simon) Hendrickson was living in Virginia around the time the Continental Navy was established during the American Revolution.

? Simeon (Simon) Hendrickson lived in Virginia, in 1775.

Simon Hendrick is credited to 200 acres of land on the waters of Booth's creek, adjoining lands claimed by John Evans, to include his improvements there in 1776. Approved 26 Apr 1781, at the home of Col. Henry Tuckers, near Morgantown, Virginia.

Menallen Twp Early History

Menallen is in the Redstone Valley. A number of Quakers moved there from Virginia after the Revolutionary War and built a meeting house in that area as early as 1784. In December 1797, Redstone Twp was formed from the west and northwest part of Menallen.

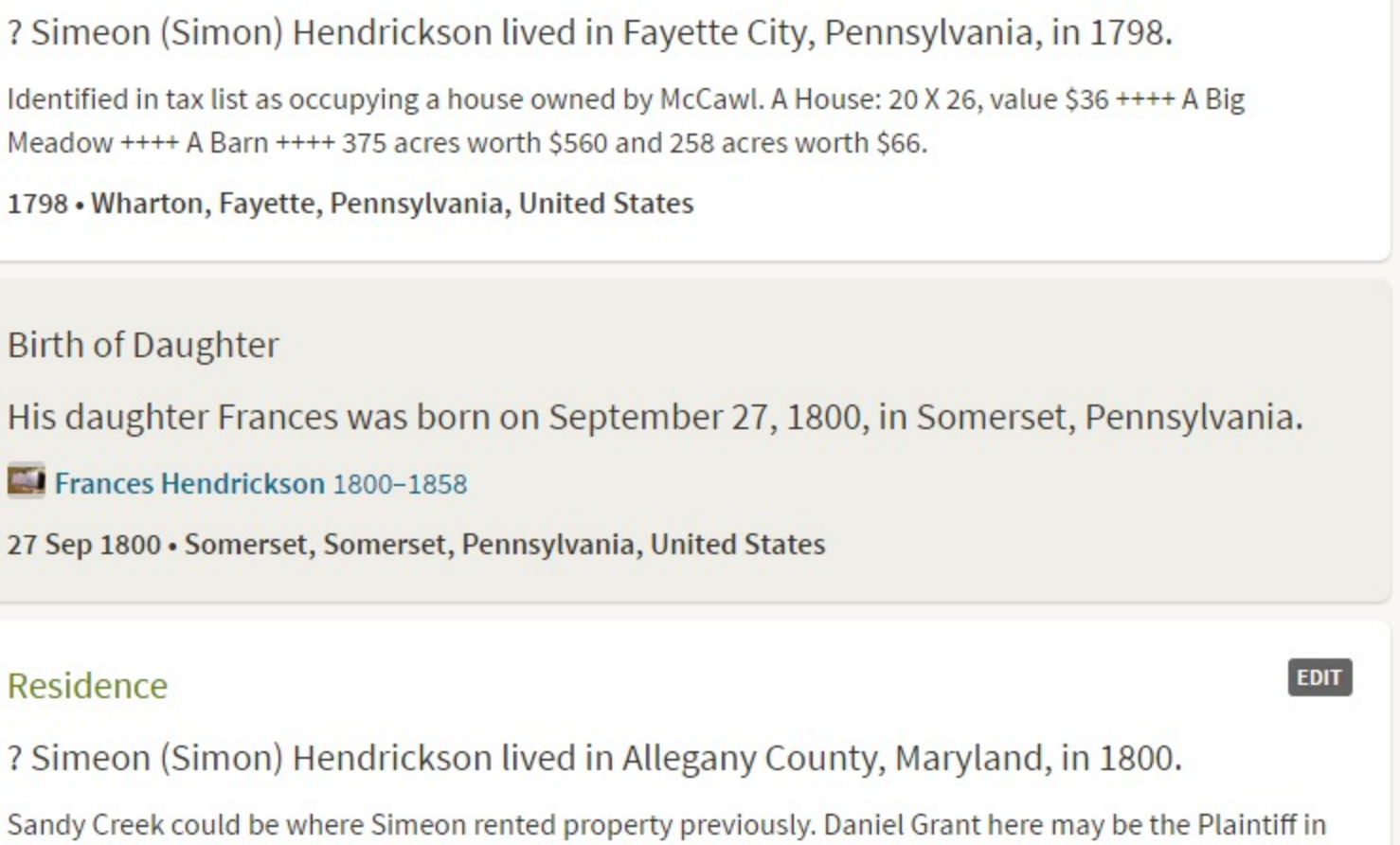

Court Case

Simeon Hendrickson appeared in court as both a tenant [before 1798?] and witness for his landlord (Grant), the plaintiff in this court case. From "Maryland Reports, Being a Series of Important Law Cases," Vol. 4, 1818, 419-20.

Identified in tax list as occupying a house owned by McCawil. A House: 20 X 26, value \$36 +++ A Big Meadow +++ A Barn +++ 375 acres worth \$560 and 258 acres worth \$66.

? Simeon (Simon) Hendrickson lived in Allegany County, Maryland, in 1800.

Sandy Creek could be where Simeon rented property previously. Daniel Grant here may be the Plaintiff in the previous law suit. Note that Philip Firebaugh and presumably his wife Barbara Hendrickson, a possible daughter of Simeon, reside here too now.

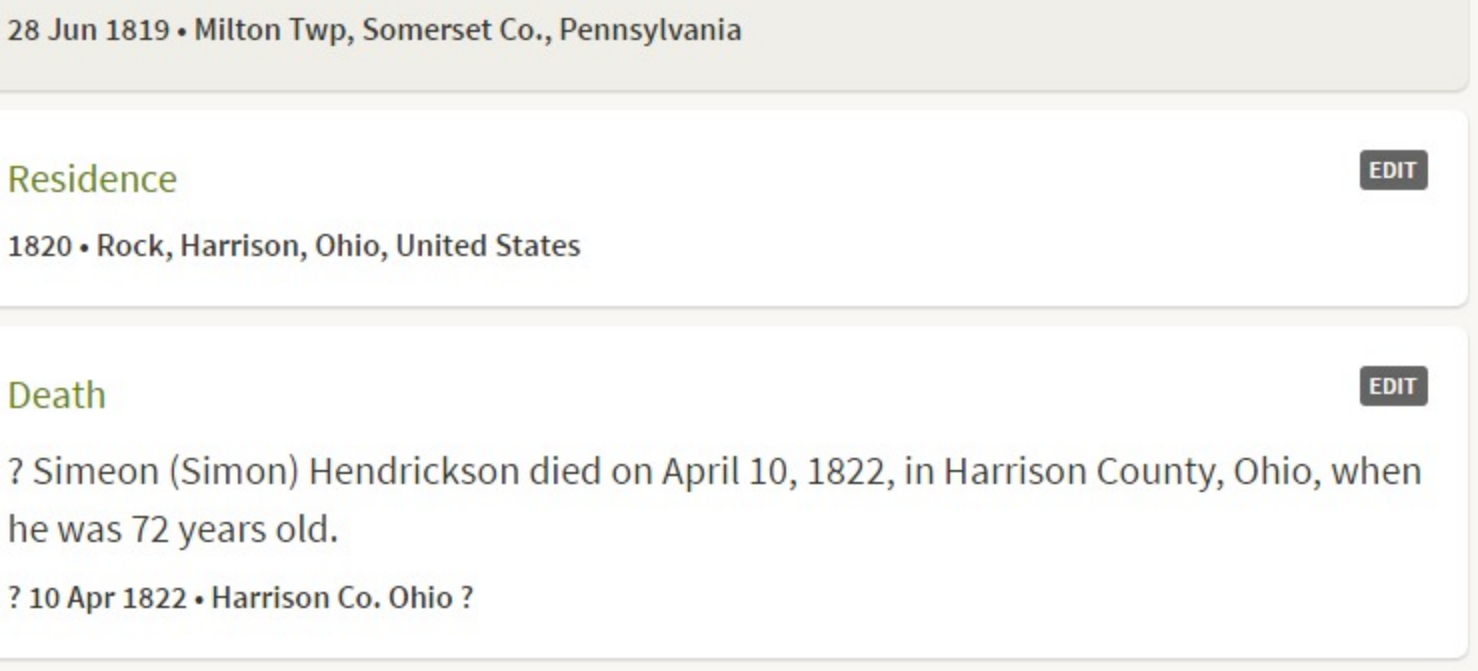
? Simeon (Simon) Hendrickson lived in Somerset, Pennsylvania, in 1810.

Deed of Trust

A Deed of Trust between Simeon Hendrickson and Levy Hendrickson, recorded in Somerset County, Pennsylvania - related to a debt Simeon owed John Philip Finkle, presumably for Simeon's purchase of Finkle's property near Dr. Levi Hendrickson.

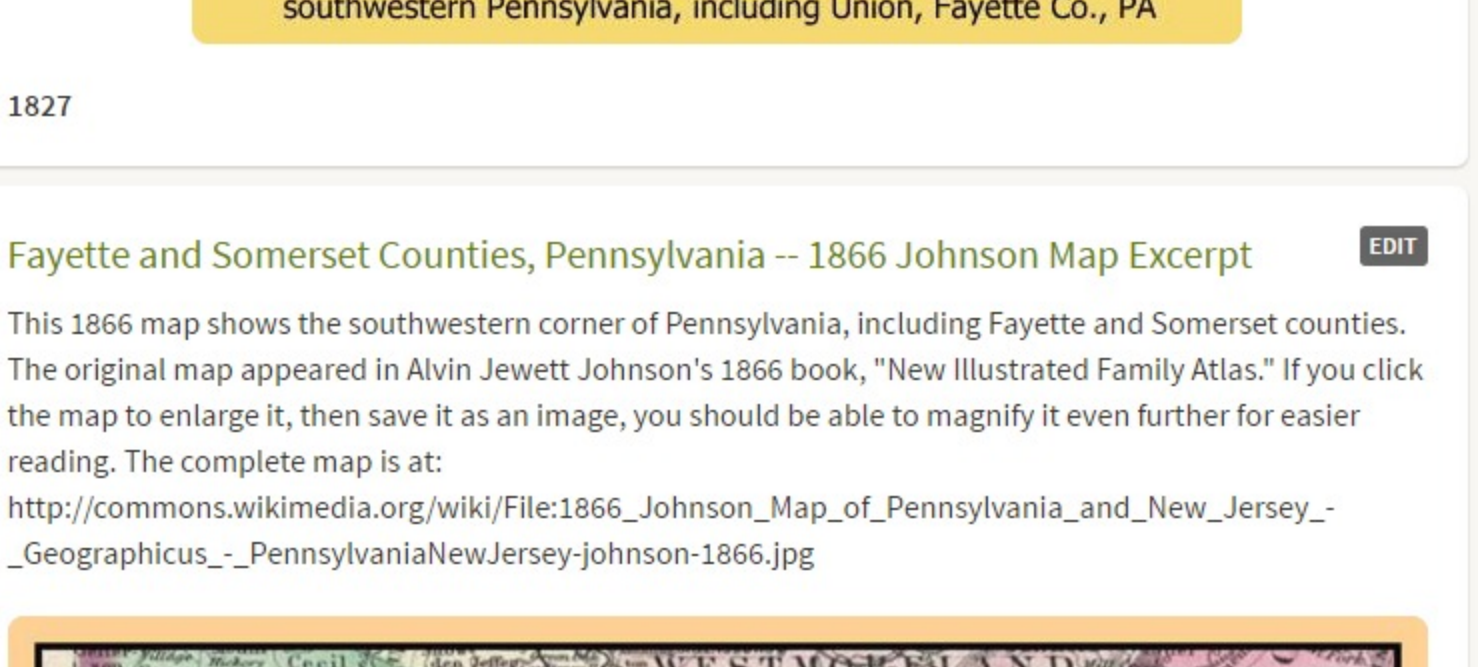

The Land That Became Allegany County, Maryland

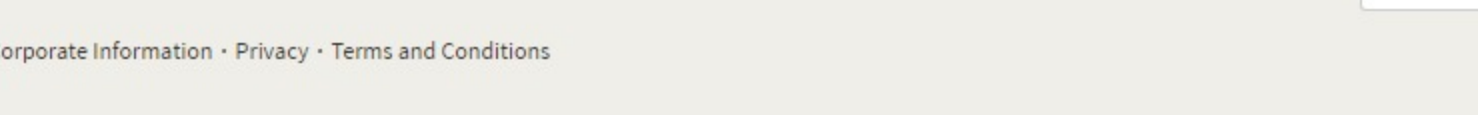
